

Some Important Rules regarding admission :

1. Students coming from other universities will not be admitted unless they have produced of proper Migration Certificate and necessary permission from Kalyani University.
2. A candidate who appeared but could not obtain pass marks in any subject at previous examination will not be allowed to take up that subject in the Degree Course.
3. Eligibility for Pursuing Honours Course of studies : A candidate taking Honours Course in a subject must have obtained :
 - i) A minimum of 50% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

- ii) 55% marks in the subject or related subject and 45% marks in aggregate at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

- iii) 55% marks in aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject or any related subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other classes are satisfied.
4. Students in Arts are not allowed to take Mathematics as their combination subject.
 5. The student should read instruction carefully before filling up the Admission Form.
 6. Candidates should selected combination subject with utmost care as no change will be allowed afterwards.
 7. At the time of Admission, H.S. Marks Sheet, M.P. Admit Card, School leaving Certificate S.C. / S.T. / O.B.C.- A / O.B.C. – B & P.H. Certificate including Bank Challan or Fees receive original etc. in original must be produced and self attested photo copy of the same must be enclosed with the Admission Form.
 8. Reservation of S.C. / S.T. / O.B.C.- A / O.B.C. – B & P.H. will be followed as per rules of Govt. & University(S.C. – 22%, S.T. – 6%, O.B.C. (A) – 10%, O.B.C. (B) – 7% & P.H. – 3%) .
 9. Candidates Shall be allowed for admission with in 3 (three) consecutive academic session including the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination.
For Example : Candidates Passing H.S. Examination in the year 2018 will get Last chance of admission in the academic session 2020-21.

General Rules for Students

1. The students must bear his / her College Identity card always in the College premises.
2. The students shall be Considered as Collegiate if he / she has attended at least 75% lectures delivered in each subject. Below 60% attendance of lectures shall be treated as discollegate and shall be deprived of papering University Examination.
3. The minimum no of attendance must be maintained during the 1st month, without which the authority may strike off the names from the register.
4. III behaviour / display of violence in the Campus are punishable. Ragging strictly Prohibited.
5. Students must maintain discipline in the corridors, library and class rooms.
6. Students are not permitted to use cellular phones in the Corridors, Classes, Library, Examination Hall and inform of the office.
7. Any form of damage of college prosperities are seriously punishable, If and body be detected his / her admission will be cancelled.
